


It takes all of us...and we all have something to give

Our core staff is supplemented by faithful Volunteers with a heart for children – college students, retirees, former military, and business people - who all pour into the students lives. We are privately funded and have a generous \$250,000 corporate \$1 for \$1 match in place through 9/2016

What can I do??


Reach4Hope provides a safe, nurturing place where expectations are high, and children are taught standards of excellence.
